The Behavior Analyst provides assessment, consultation, interventions and service planning based on the principles and procedures of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA). The Behavior Analyst focuses on developing and expanding communication skills, building relationships, enhancing pro-social behaviors, increasing compliance with PDP goals and progress monitoring, reducing problem behavior or behaviors that interfere with acquisition of developmentally appropriate life skills. They are primarily responsible for the functional behavioral analysis of target behaviors and skills, adaptive functioning assessments, intervention design and implementation, including Positive Behavioral Support Planning and staff training or coaching.

The Behavior Analyst will also provide consultation and assistance to RN Care Managers and service coordinators, including monitoring development and acquisition of adaptive skills, and implementation of the intervention plans.

Required Education: Masters degree in ABA or related field. Current Board Certified Behavior Analyst Certificate.

Testing Requirements: Pre-employment tests including drug/alcohol and TB Screening
