Job Summary

The Lecturer position in Psychology is a board certified behavior analyst (BCBA) and will primarily be responsible for: (a) providing individual supervision for students in applied behavior analysis at clinical sites; (b) ensuring the quality of supervised experience for students, including appropriate documentation of supervision; and © assisting in the coordination between the applied behavior analysis (ABA) faculty who are providing group supervision and the on-site, field experience BCBA's; assisting ABAfaculty in establishing and maintaining quality field-experience settings; and depending on the supervision caseload, may teach undergraduate online and/or on-campus classes in applied behavior analysis.

Minimum Qualifications

1. Board Certified Behavior Analyst
2. Master's degree in psychology, education, or behavior analysis
3. Eligible for licensure as a behavior analyst in the state of Alabama

Preferred Qualifications

1. Meets the Behavior Analysis Certification Board's requirements for an approved, experienced supervisor
2. Knowledgeable of the Behavior Analysis Certification Board's supervised experience requirements
3. Experience supervising and training behavior analysts
4. Five years post degree clinical experience
